**Each shift will need someone who can man the grill We do ask that younger 4-H members not be allowed to work in the concession. There are times when it is really busy and this will help in keeping



The 2023 Texas 4-H Opportunity Scholarship application and guidelines are now available. High school seniors that have been 4-H members for at least 3 years and meet other criteria may apply for one of the following: Baccalaureate scholarships; Technical scholarship; or Courageous Heart scholarship. Collegiate scholarships are available for former 4-H members that have been in college for at least one year, have completed at least 30 hours of college course work, and meet some additional requirements.
